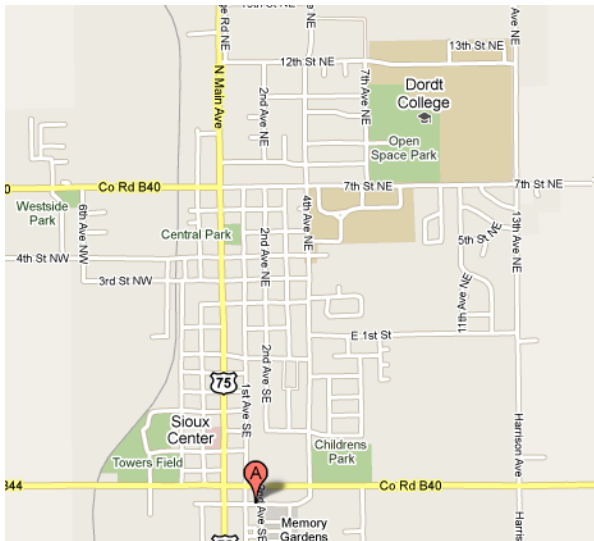


WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Tim Vink grew up in Minnesota attending American Reformed Church in Luverne, MN. He attended Northwestern College to follow a call to pastoral ministry.

After graduation from Fuller Seminary in 1991, Tim served RCA churches in Los Angeles, Iowa, central California, and Michigan. As the senior pastor of Tulare Community Church in California, Tim worked to start nine churches in nine years and helped the Classis of Central California pursue a vision from Christ to become 32 reproducing churches by 2020.

In 2002, Tim joined with other RCA pastors to found the Healing Rooms of Tulare and has participated in hundreds of healing/deliverance ministry events over the last 23 years.

Since 2005 Tim has served the RCA as the Coordinator for Church Multiplication, stewarding a vision to see 400 new congregations planted by 2014. Tim lives with his family in Zeeland, Michigan and is the happy husband to Dana and father to three daughters.
